### Poster and Presentation Evening

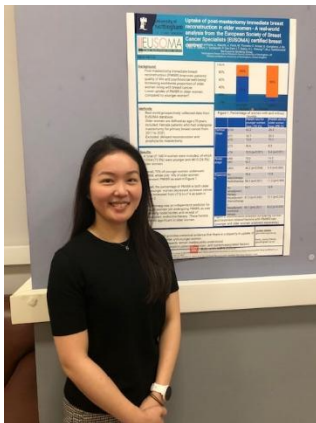

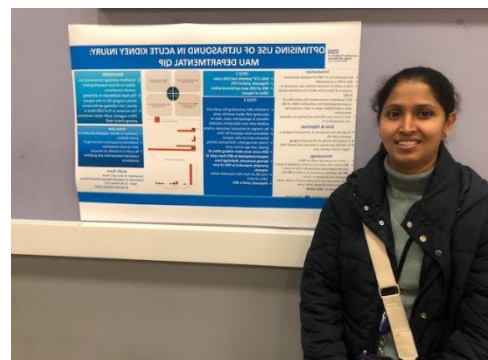

Dr Stuart was a well known and highly respected GP in Vernon Street and Park Farm Allestree, where he worked for many years with his late wife, Dr Ruth Stuart. He was very supportive of DMS, being President in 1987-1988. A minutes silence was observed.

Prof Judd announced the winner for highest academic achievement in preclinical studies from the Graduate Entry Medical students and presented the award to Jimmy Xu.
