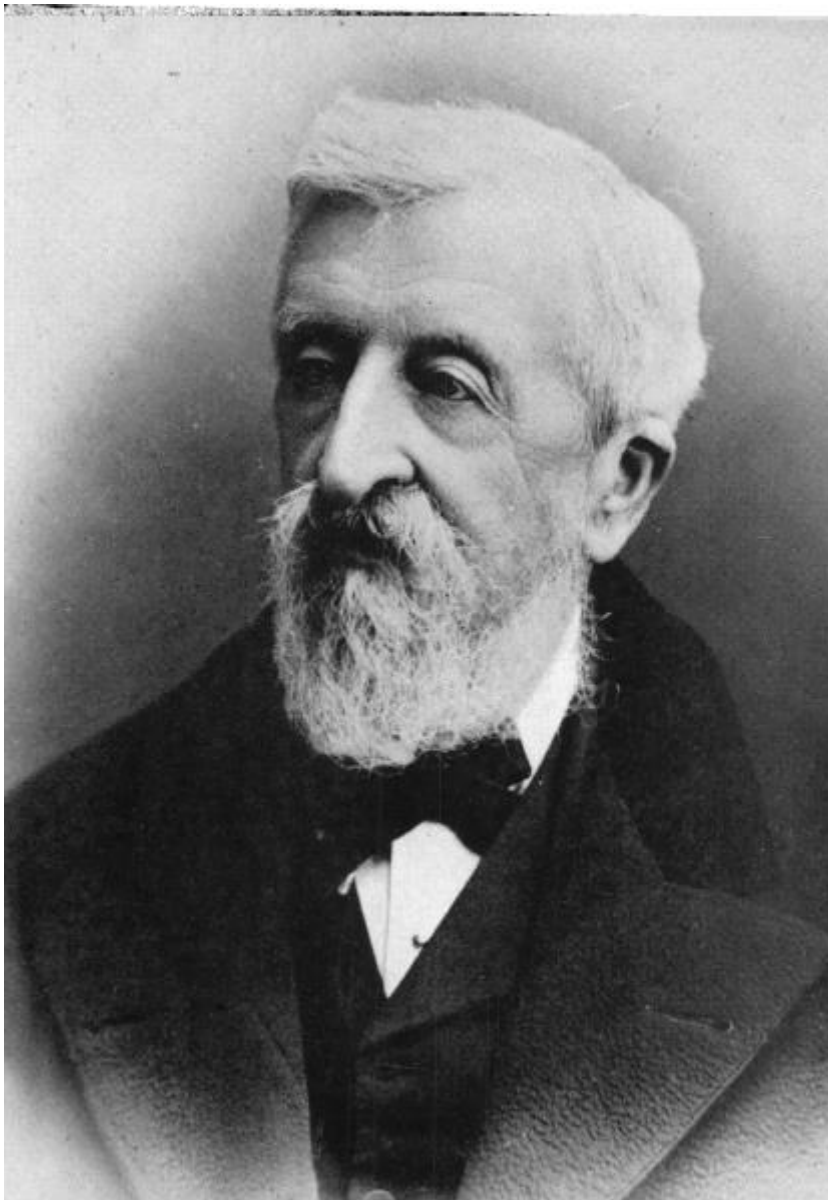

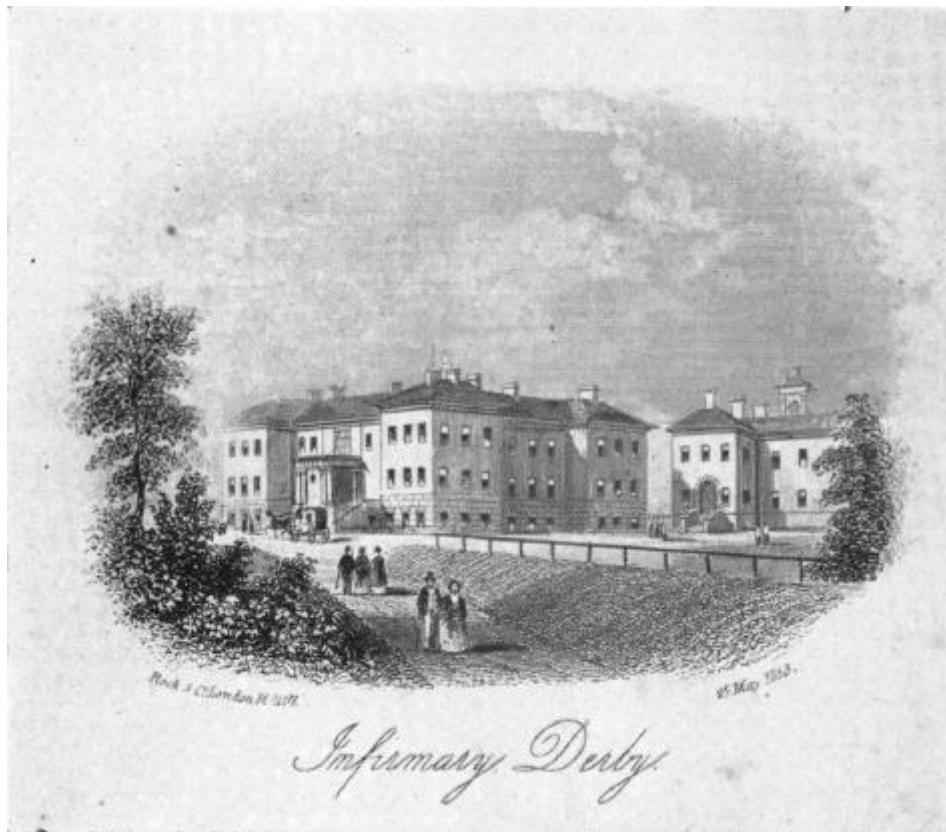
Introduction

The Derby Medical Society was founded in 1862 for the purpose of bringing together medical practitioners from the many diverse branches of medicine to discuss the medical science of the day and to present and discuss cases of interest to its members.

One of its founders, William Ogle (1824-1905) was Derby's first Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and a longstanding Physician to what came to be known as the Derbyshire Royal Infirmary. Of historical importance are the letters that Ogle wrote to Florence Nightingale during the expansion of the Infirmary. Her correspondence to him is preserved in the British Museum's Nightingale Manuscripts. Facsimiles of his letters to her are held within this collection.

After retirement, William Ogle translated from classical Greek the various works of Aristotle, notably *On the Parts of Animals*, a copy of which he presented to Charles Darwin in 1882.

To this day, the society maintains the spirit and motivation of its founders through the presentation of a yearly lecture series featuring keynote speakers from all walks of medicine, many of whom have world renowned reputations in their field. Additionally, the society has a proud tradition of supporting the medical community through its long standing association with the Royal Medical Benevolent Fund and through the provision of bursaries and awards for medical students and trainees.

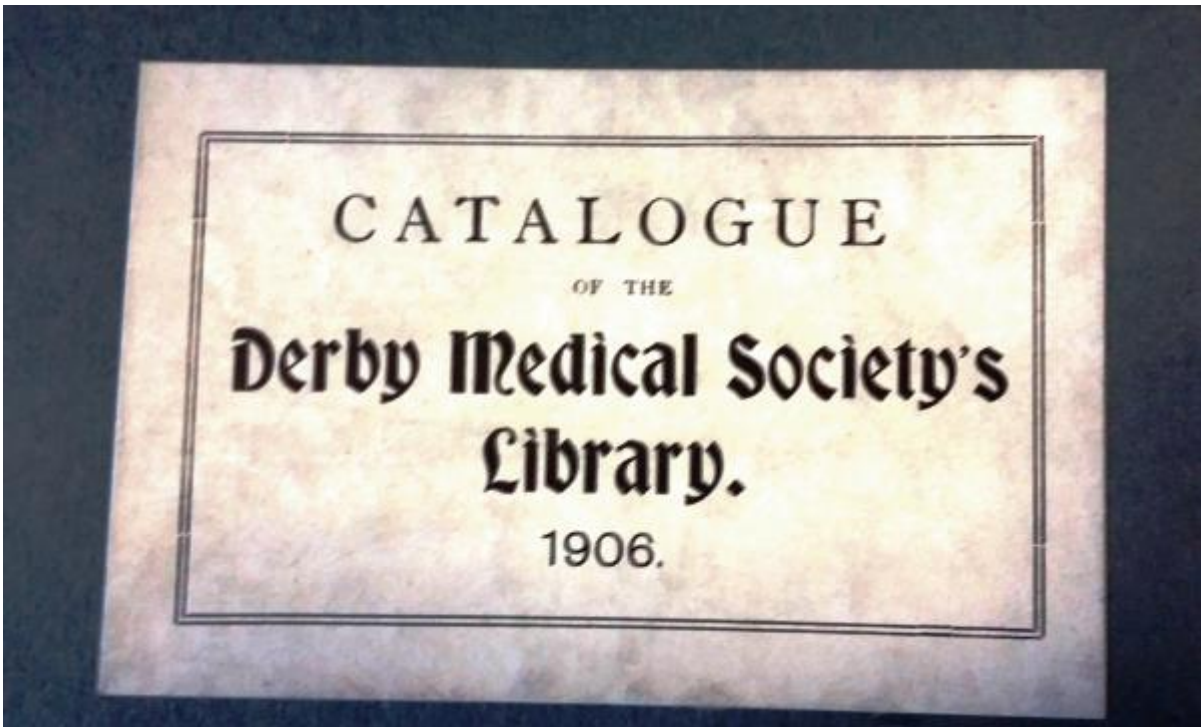
The Derby Medical Society has held their archive within the Library and Knowledge Service since the mid 1980's. The archive has recently been catalogued for prosperity on our library management system.

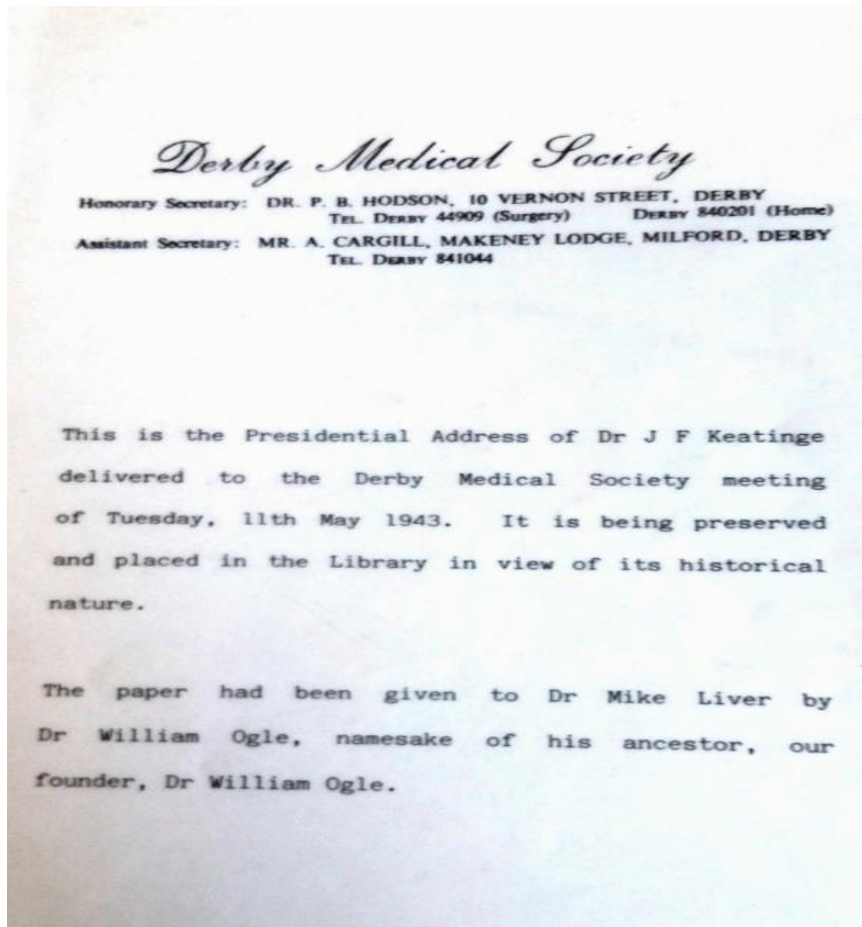
Catalogue of the Derby Medical Society's Library



This document is a catalogue to the Derby Medical Society's Library, dated 1906. The Library holds 45 copies of the catalogue in the Derby Medical Society Archive.

Each catalogue is typed and bound in a green hardback booklet. There are 34 pages in each booklet. The collections within the catalogue span from A to W and includes titles such as "The Microscope and it's Revelations," (1862) "Portraits, Memoirs and Characters of Remarkable Persons from Reign of Edward Third to Revolution" (1813), "The Mirror of Dentistry" (1852) and "Course of Lectures in Pharmacy" (1723)

Derby Doctors and Hospitals

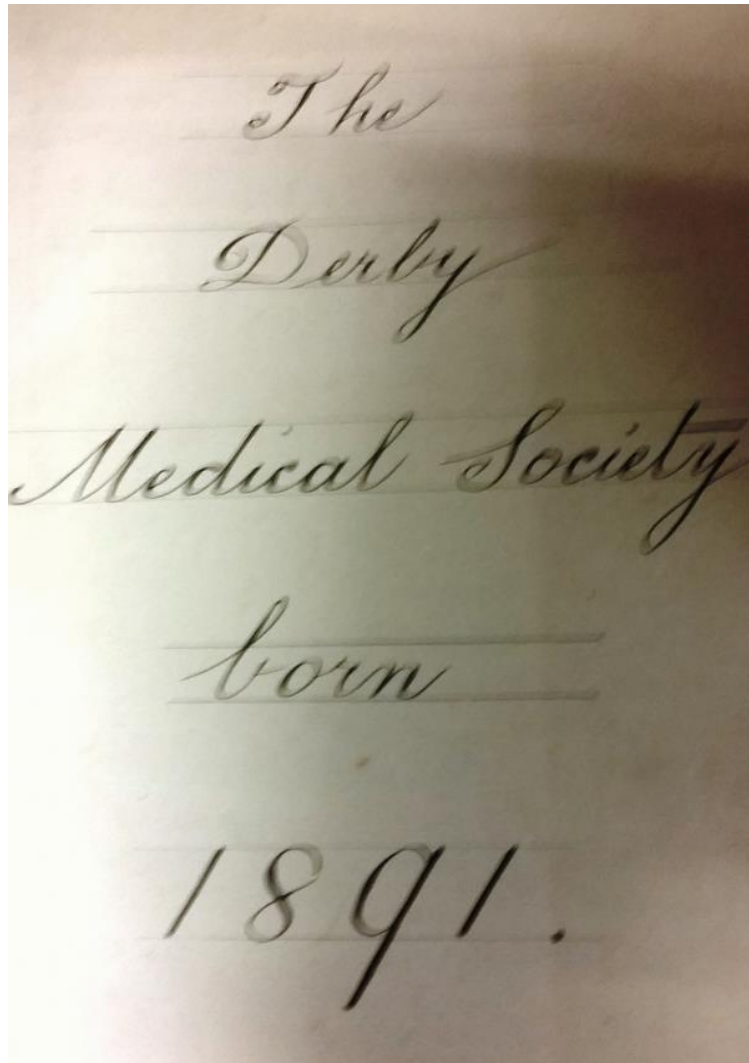


This document is a piece of research on the history of doctors and hospitals in Derby from the Romans until the formation of the Infirmary in 1810. It is typewritten and is held together by a slide binder.

The front of the document states; "This is the Presidential Address of Dr J F Keatinge delivered to the Derby Medical Society meeting of Tuesday, 11th May 1943. It is being preserved and placed in the Library in view of its historical nature. The paper had been given to Dr Mike Liver by Dr William Ogle, namesake of his ancestor, our founder, Dr William Ogle."

Annual Meeting and President' Address, 1943-1958

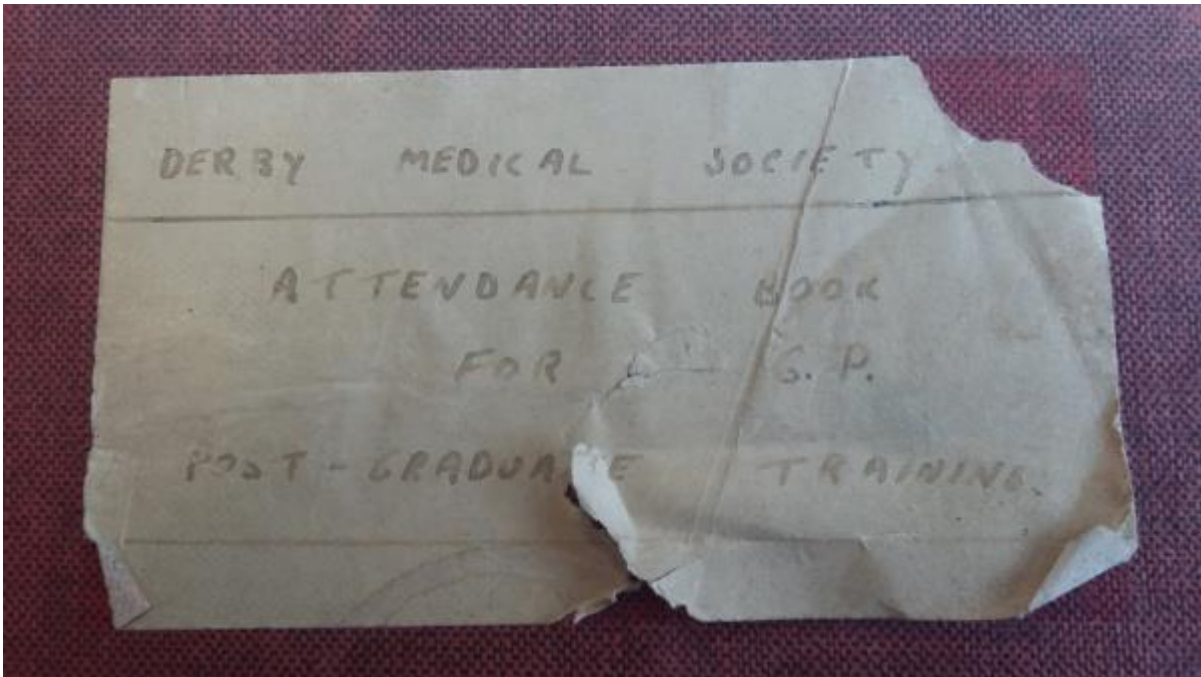

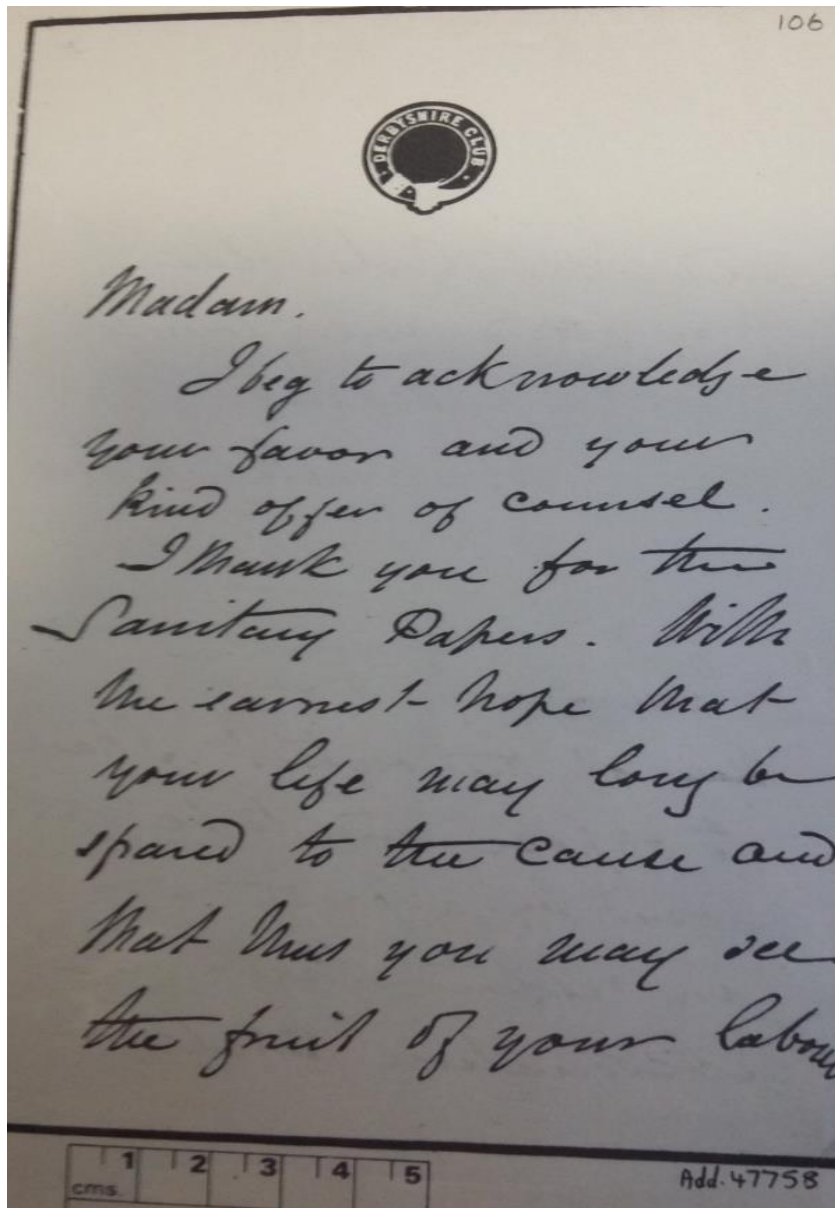

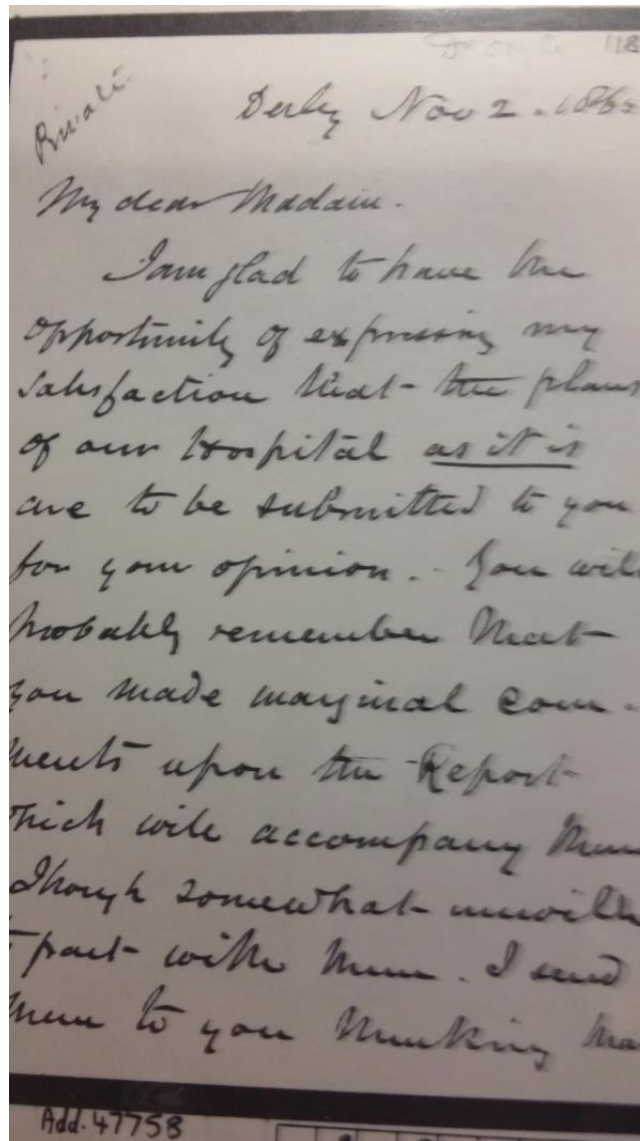

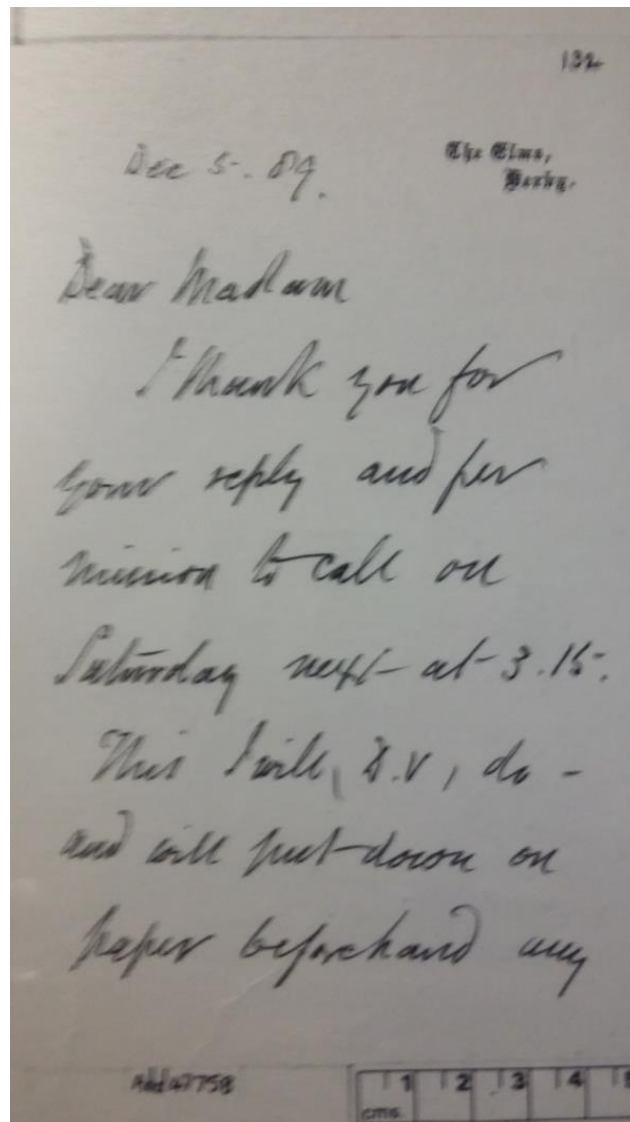

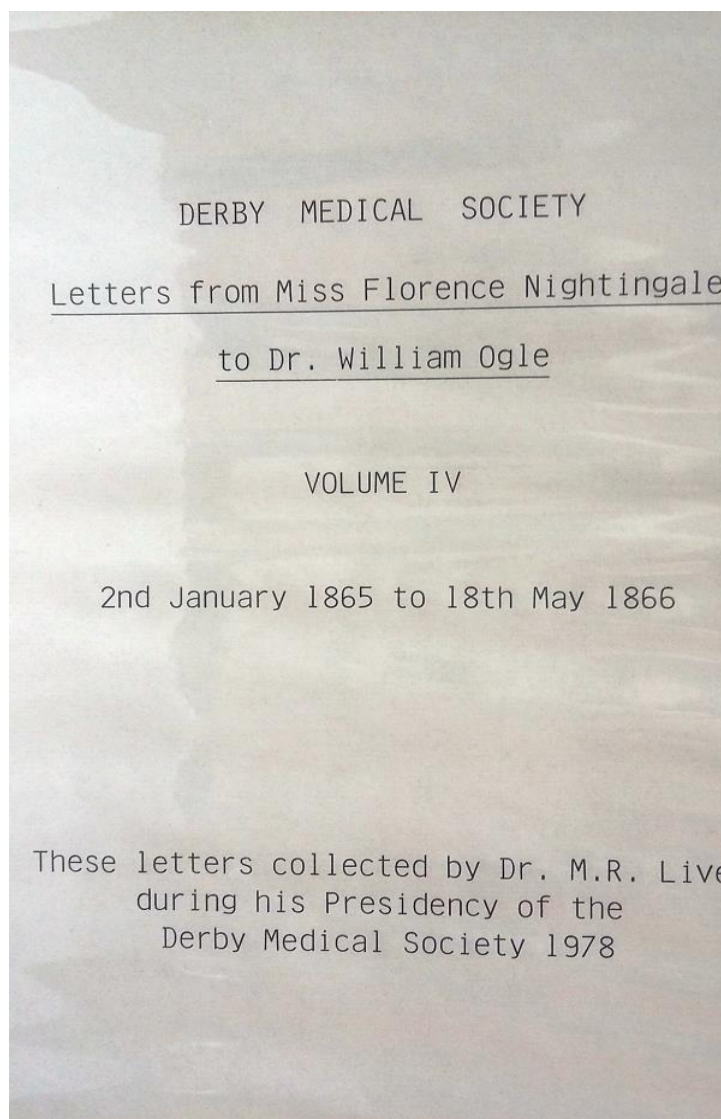

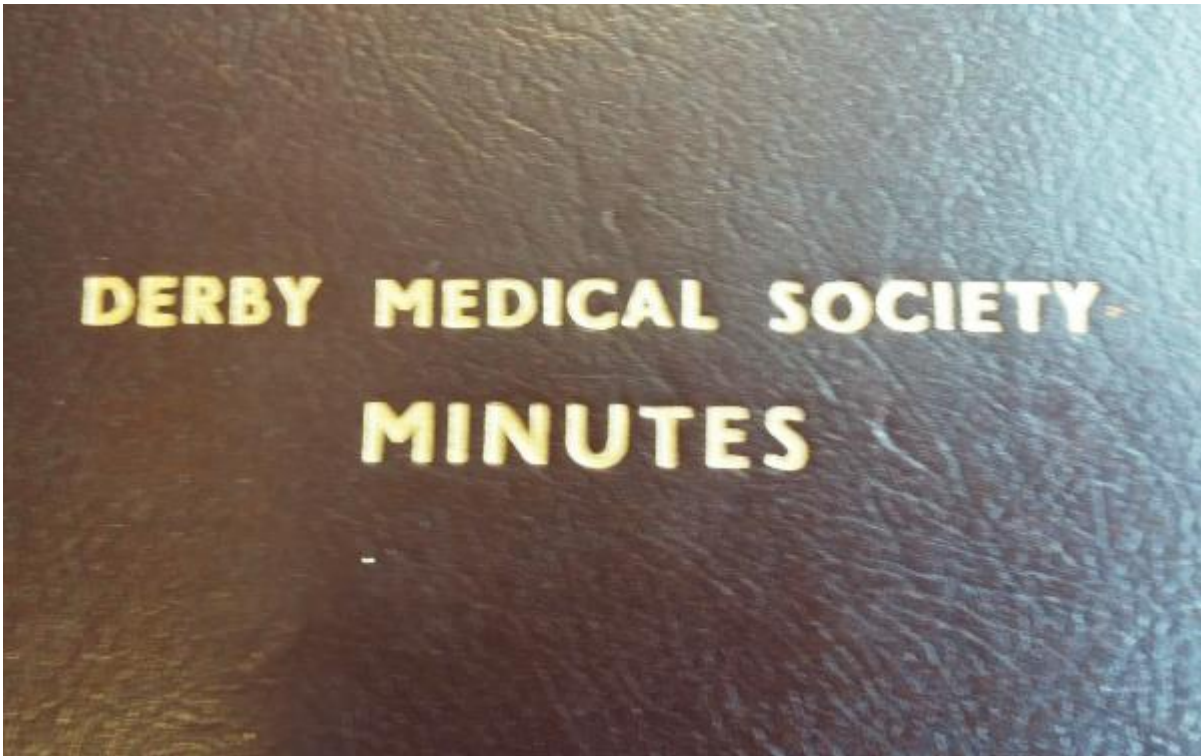

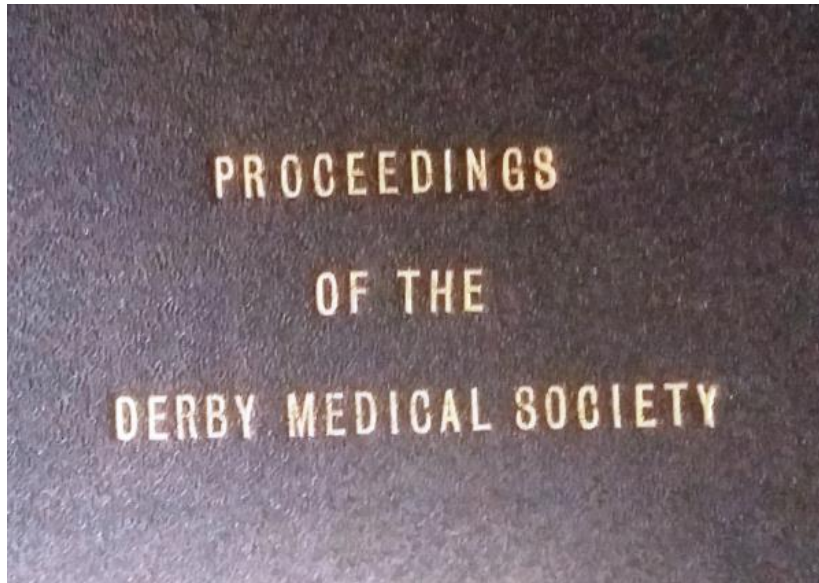
